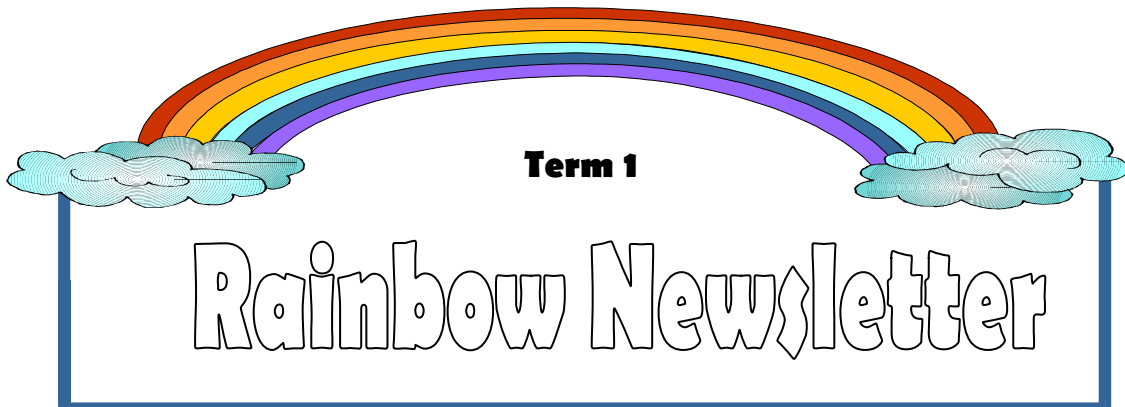

I English

If your child has been with us since Nursery, he/she would have had one year of phonics background. If your child is new and has no phonics background, the teachers will be going through the previous sounds on a regular basis. By the end of Term One, your child would have covered the following sounds in addition to those already covered at Nursery level:

- 'Y' - as in yak
- 'Z' - as in zebra
- 'Ā' - as in ape
- 'E' - as in emu
- 'G' - as in gerbil
- 'I' - as in ibex
- 'O' - as in okapi
- 'C' - as in civet
- 'U' - as in unicorn

An animal story together with a song and relevant activities, help reinforce each phonic sound. You may keep the Word Building books, English Workbooks, and readers after they have been completed in class and sent home. At K1, there is a greater emphasis on reading and writing skills and we encourage you to read frequently with and to your child.

II Mathematics

- Rote counting 1-20
- Recognising / Writing 0-15
- Ordering Numbers 1-10
- One-to-one correspondence
- Matching / Sorting / Classifying
- Ordering Events

III Chinese

The emphasis is on listening, speaking and recognising Chinese characters through meaningful activities. The topics covered this term are:

- Things I can do
- I love my family

IV MATAL

MATAL is an early childhood programme from Israel. We hope to stretch your child's creativity through meaningful and enjoyable activities and also to develop his/her critical thinking skills. This term, they will observe the world around us and look at some of the properties of objects – colour, and opaque & transparent.



School Bag & Name Tag

Children have to carry the school bag every day. New children will receive their school bags and iron-on name tags within the first week of school. Letters from the school or notes from the teacher will be inserted in the bag, so do check your child's bag daily. When you receive notices from the Kindergarten which require a reply, we would appreciate a prompt response. If your child is required to complete some work, do supervise your child to ensure that instructions have been followed. If your child's old bag is lost or damaged, please get a replacement from the office.

All children are required to have the iron-on name tag on the uniform. Please place an order with the office if you need a set of name tags.



Term 1 Fees

Term One fees are due in the first week of the term. If you have not made payment yet, please write a cheque for the amount you have chosen (**\$674.10, \$706.20, \$738.30 or \$770.40**) and make it payable to **St James' Church Kindergarten**. Write your child's name and class at the back of the cheque. For those paying by GIRO / Baby Bonus, the fees will be deducted on 8 January 2010.
